Dr. Mohamed Eddaoudi is currently Full Professor at King Abdullah University of Science and Technology (KAUST), Jeddah, Saudi Arabia. He obtained his BSc in Chemistry from the University Ibn Zohr, Agadir Morocco in 1991 and PhD in Polymer Science from the University of Paris 7, France in 1996. He was a Postdoctoral Research Fellow at Arizona State University 1997 and Research Scientist at the University of Michigan in 1999. to join as assistant professor at the University of Florida between 2002 and 2009 where graduate to full professor. Now He is Full Professor at King Abdullah University of Science and Technology Jeddah, Saudi Arabia (KAUST) and promote to a distinguished professor in 2016.

He was awarded the Abdul Hameed Shoman Prize for Arab Researchers for this years' topic 'Renewable Energy' at the 37th session (2019).

Professor Mohamed Daoudi supervises a research group in the scientific city in Jeddah as well as in several countries, and chairs an international conference on materials science and environment in Morocco, the first was at the University of Mohammed I in 2016; the second in the city of Saidia in 2018; the third at the University of Ibn Zohr in Agadir last December (ICMES2019) and the fourth will be held at Saidia Next October (ICMES2020).

He has authored/co-authored over 230 research articles in international peer reviewed journals mostly ISI rated including several critical reviews and book chapters and some of his publications have been highly cited.
